FAMILY SERVICES HOSTS FREE HEALTH FAIR FOR AREA FAMILIES

WHAT: Family Services of Greater Houston will host the **10th Annual School Days and Community Health Fair** to recognize more than 800 students who stayed drug-free by participating in Family Services' *Ensueños del Futuro / Dreams for the Future* program, a drug use prevention and education program offered at more than 60 area schools. Students in the *Ensueños del Futuro* program will receive free school supplies to encourage them to stay in school. The health fair will feature more than 25 community organizations and health care providers.
